The Lithuanian Underwater Sport Federation – authorized by CMAS – invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate on the **XVII CMAS Finswimming World Cup 2023** – organized **28-30.IV.2023** in Klaipeda, Lithuania.

Registration process

The competition is governed by CMAS Finswimming Rules, by CMAS Finswimming World Cup Rules and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment - affirms to know and agrees to strictly follow.

Please note the following instructions regarding registration since all data of the Finswimming World Cup – Golden Final are stored in the CMAS sport database managed by SportData. The link is: <https://www.sportdata.org/cmas/>

1. Registration

All registrations of athletes for events must be submitted **only through electronic system**.

Application forms can be used only for accommodation.

Registration available only through the webpage <https://www.sportdata.org/cmas/>

Opening date of registration is **18th March 2023**.

Each competitor can take part in a maximum of **four (4)** individual races and **two (2)** relays.

2. Registration Tutorial

In order to register - you need an account

Users which already have registered an account in the CMAS system, please re-use your account. In this case you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and officials data previously submitted. If you don't have an account yet, please register online:

Steps of registration for competitors, coaches, referees and officials:

Log in using your account

- Check if the team data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- If the event calendar sends to the event you want to register for, click on the “Registration” button of the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the registration page you will find the functions to add new entries.
- Register your competitors / teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials.
- All your registrations will be submitted to a waiting list for validation. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved and you will be notified by email.
- You can find an overview about all your registrations at “My current entries”. There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the “Other Items” section of the event. The organizer may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

Please, read the attached notice with the new instructions for 2023.

- In 2023, you need to enter all categories of people who will attend the competition, not only the competitors.
- From now on, we will use the system to print the accreditation to access the swimming pool. For this reason, besides the competitors, you need to enter all members of your club:
 - Competitors
 - Coaches
 - Referees
 - Officials (all categories).
- Note: the registration of non-competitors is free of charge. No CMAS fees will be charged for the categories of Coaches, Referees and all Officials. To finish, the ID photo must be uploaded, whatever the category.
- After the deadline, the accreditations will be printed and sent to the organizing committee, and you will receive them upon arrival.

Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees

For each round or Golden Final, each competitor must pay CMAS fee, fixed annually by CMAS.

- **22 €** for each round.

Please note that the names of relays members must be entered during individual registration process even if they swim only relay. According to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on place before the beginning of competition.

These fees will be paid at the end of the registration process online by credit card.

b. Miscellaneous

- Fees paid for races not performed will not be reimbursed
- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after deadline according registration planning. Bank information is confidential. It will be sent to you upon request by mail at:

c. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to organising committee according to the instructions communicated below: felicita.vaitkute@gintarosc.lt, felvait@gmail.com

Inscription fees are:

- **22 €** for each club;
- **15.50 €** per each relay;
 - **8 €** per each individual distance

Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.

Late enrolments are not accepted because registration is managed by CMAS system during registration planning.

Participation rules and races

1. Races and categories are as follows:

SENIOR (Cat. "A") M/W (18 years old and older)

50 m AP, 100 m IM., 50 m SF., 100 m SF., 200 m SF., 400 m SF., 800 m SF., 50 m BF., 100 m BF., 200 m BF., 400 m BF.

Relay: 4 x 100 m SF., Relay: 4 x 100 m BF mixed.

JUNIOR (Cat. "B, C, D") B/G (12 – 17 years old)

50 m AP, 100 m IM., (competitors of Cat „D“ cannot enter)

50 m SF., 100 m SF., 200 m SF., 400 m SF., 800 m SF., 50 BF., 100 m BF., 200 m BF., 400 m BF.

Relay: 4 x 100 m SF., Relay: 4 x 100 m BF mixed.

Competition place

The competition will take place at:

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, 10 lanes and a depth of 2m. The temperature of the water is 26°C (+- 1°C). There are 1000 places on tribunes

Timekeeping system

Electronic. Omega Qantum system.

Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorized to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions. All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition.

Classifications

Classifications will be based on the results which will be compiled according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- There will be classification for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries.
- Individual: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for men, women, Juniors Boys and girls. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.
- Club: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual point (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for seniors men, seniors women, juniors boys and juniors girls.
- National Teams: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual point (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, juniors boys, juniors girls.
- Countries Ranking:
- The Countries Ranking will be made in accordance with points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
- If National Federation does not enrol its National team, the best two results by club in accordance with points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, woman, juniors and seniors) will go to Countries ranking.

Prizes

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams prizes: cups for first three clubs and cups for first three National Teams. Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes must be at organizing staff's disposal at the right time.

During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear official uniforms of their teams.

The Organizing Federation, the Organizing Committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. these rules as a condition of participation.

Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organizers. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment complete at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

Accommodation and transportation

The Hotel Green Park is located next to the swimming pool, so it is just a 6 minutes walk. It gives the athletes the possibility to come back and rest everytime it is needed. The hotel is also pretty close to the city center. It takes 10 min to get there by car or bus.



*Please notice that the number of rooms is limited - the order of applications decides.

- 1. Accommodation and full board is offered - 170 EURO / person (rooms with 2-3 beds*)**
- 2. Single room - extra price - 40 EURO/ person /day**
- 3. Extra day - 75 EURO / person /day**
- 4. Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official will have to pay 30,00 Euro per person per day for secretarial**
- 5. Transportation from the airport (arrival and departure):**
 - 35 € / person / from aeroport Vilnius
 - 32 € / person/ from aeroport Ryga
 - 30 € / person / from aeroport Kaunas
 - 15 € / person / from aeroport Palanga
